about the event

The Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk presented by Hyundai raises the most money of any single-day walk in the nation and has raised more than \$155 million since 1989 for Dana-Farber Cancer Institute's fight against cancer. In 2021, more than 6,100 participants walked virtually and raised \$7.1 million.

The Jimmy Fund Walk has been raising money to defy cancer for more than a quarter century. In 2022, we anticipate 7,500 walkers, 850 volunteers, and hope to raise \$7.8 million to support Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund.

In 1989, 667 walkers raised \$161,014 at the inaugural Boston Marathon Jimmy Fund Walk.

fundraising information

walker agreement

Fundraising Minimum Anyone who participates in the Jimmy Fund Walk is required to raise a minimum amount. Youth participants include anyone under 18 years of age.

- \$330 for Adults In-person (\$30 registration fee)
- \$130 for Youth In-person (\$30 registration fee)
- \$100 for Adults Virtual (\$10 registration fee)
- \$30 Youth Virtual (\$10 registration fee)

Credit Card Policy To complete registration, all participants must provide credit card information. In the event that the fundraising minimum is not met by October 31, 2022, the participant's credit card is charged the remaining balance.

Example: If a walker has raised \$200 by October 31, 2022, the credit card the walker used to pay the registration fee is charged the remaining \$130.

Cancellation Policy Participants who cancel by September 30, 2022, are not responsible for the fundraising minimum. **Any registered walkers who have not cancelled by this date are required to submit the fundraising minimum even if they do not attend the event.**

Your registration fee is non-refundable and goes toward the minimum.

gift acknowledgement from dana-farber cancer institute

Supporters receive a tax acknowledgment email if they make a credit card gift online of any amount.

Supporters receive a tax acknowledgment in the mail if they submit a check of \$50 or more. The letter is sent to the name and address printed on the check.





what to bring

Seasoned walkers recommend you bring the following items:

- Sunglasses and sunscreen—even if it's not sunny
- Extra socks (TIP: Rather than cotton, try a pair made of wicking material)
- A mini first-aid kit with adhesive bandages and pain relievers
- Wallet with identification and a small amount of cash and/or credit card
- Cell phone
- Reuseable water bottle
- Cash and credit cards (new this year: there will be a merchandise tent at the Finish Line!)

what not to bring

- Large strollers or backpacks (Only collapsible strollers are permitted on buses)
- Inline skates, skateboards, bicycles, scooters, etc.
- Pets (service animals are allowed)

Walkers may check in, register for the Walk, and pick up all Walk day items on Saturday, October 1, from 1:30 to 3:30 PM at Wellesley High School.

where to go and what to do

START

At each of the start locations and at Early Check-in, there will be designated areas:

- **Bib and T-Shirt Pick Up** If you haven't received your bib and/or T-shirt you can pick them up here
- **Food and Beverage** Fuel up for your walk with some snacks and beverages
- **Pacesetter Items** Walkers who raise \$1,500 (or \$500 more for those under 18 years old) can pick up their bibs, hats, stickers, and more if they have not yet received them
- **Registration** Need to register? Head here on Walk day
- **Top 250 Club** Walkers who are 2021 Top 250 Club members can pick up their bibs, T-shirts, hats, and patches here

** You may collect an "I'm Living Proof" button and hat if you are a cancer survivor or current patient and turn in any money that you have collected and not yet submitted at any of the tables (refer to page 21 for additional information on collecting and submitting gifts)*

*** If you have already received your bib and T-shirt, you may begin walking and do not need to check in*

HELP THE WALK GO GREEN

Participants are encouraged to carpool or take public transportation. Please use the trash and recycling receptacles along the course for anything you need to discard. Bring a reusable waterbottle to refill as you go!

ALONG THE ROUTE

** Please note: Roads are open to regular vehicular traffic during the Jimmy Fund Walk. For your safety and the safety of your fellow walkers, please stay within coned lanes and obey all pedestrian traffic signs and police officer directions.*

Support is provided for walkers on each route:

- 12 refueling stations are located along the Marathon Walk route with snacks, beverages, port-a-johns, and medical support
- Medical "sweep" buses drive along the route. To catch a ride, wait at a refueling station or a mile marker along the route. If you encounter a life-threatening emergency, please call 911






