

Official Rules

Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will invite eligible participants of the 2019 Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk (the “Event”), via email, Facebook (<http://www.facebook.com/JimmyFundWalk> and <http://www.facebook.com/TheJimmyFund>), and the Event website (<http://www.jimmyfundwalk.org>), to recruit walkers for the Event. Participants who complete the following may be eligible for the Contest described below: (i) register for the Event and (ii) recruit one (1) or more walkers to register for the Event (the “Participants”). The top thirty (30) Participants who recruit the most walkers as of September 22, 2019 at 11:59pm ET will be eligible to receive the prize described below (the “Contest”).

In order to qualify as having recruited a walker, one (1) or more walkers (virtual walkers included) must complete the following on or before September 22, 2019 at 11:59pm ET: (i) register for the Event, (ii) provide the first and last name of the Participant who referred them to the Event (the “Referrer”) in the “Name of Person Who Referred You” field on the Event registration page, and (iii) commit to raise the minimum fundraising requirement* (the “Referred Participants”). All Referred Participants and Referrers may register for the Event as an individual or by joining at team. Volunteers do not qualify as Referred Participants.

The winners will be determined at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts, on September 27, 2019 at 08:00am ET. The Senior Vice President for Philanthropy, or their designee, shall be responsible for determining the names of thirty (30) potential winners.

The potential winners will be notified by DFCI via phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached after fourteen (14) days from the first notification attempt, or if a Participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a Participant declines “winner” status, that Participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI’s sole discretion. Prizes will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Contest, a Participant must, as of the date of entry, be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia.

NO PURCHASE OR CONTRIBUTION NECESSARY TO ENTER. The odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries received. The thirty (30) Participants who, after meeting the criteria described above, recruit the highest number of Referred Participants will be eligible to win a one (1) year supply of Cape Cod potato chips, which includes: one (1) variety bag of potato chips per month from Cape Cod Potato Chips for twelve (12) consecutive months. This prize has a combined fair market value of five hundred dollars (\$500) per person.

All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is September 22, 2019 at 11:59pm ET.

Prizes are non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should a prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

The identities of the winners may be obtained by contacting the Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk staff at jimmyfundwalk@dfci.harvard.edu on or after October 14, 2019 at 11:00am ET.

Any valuation of the prize stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winners are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winners may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person defined a DFCI employee winning over \$100 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form W-2 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of

such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in the Contest described above, Participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest, and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All Participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the Contest, including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a Participant's ability to participate in the Contest. DFCI is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The Contest is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the Contest, each Participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.

*The minimum fundraising requirement (registration fee not included) for participants ages thirteen (13) and older registered as a walker is three hundred dollars (\$300) and for participants registered as a virtual walker is one hundred dollars (\$100); the minimum fundraising requirement (registration fee not included) for youth participants ages twelve (12) and under as of Event day and registered as a walker is one hundred dollars (\$100) and for participants registered as a virtual walker is twenty-five dollars (\$25).
