| <b>What You Need</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ A <a href="#">BingoMaker.com</a> account</li><li>■ A <a href="#">My Jimmy Fund Event Page</a> to collect donations from registrants</li><li>■ An email account to send gamers their Bingo cards</li><li>■ An account to livestream or video conference from, such as Facebook Live or Zoom</li></ul>  |
| <b>How it Works</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Create your Bingo cards on <a href="#">BingoMaker.com</a>.</li><li>■ Create a <a href="#">My Jimmy Fund Event Page</a> where your participants can register for your Bingo Night. Ticket sales will be part of your fundraising revenue. Be sure to include details in the description about when and how your Bingo Night will be livestreamed.</li><li>■ Spread the word about your game on social media with friends and family by creating a Facebook Event.</li><li>■ On event day, download your Bingo cards from <a href="#">BingoMaker.com</a> as PDFs and send them to your participants. Instruct participants to either print or copy down their Bingo card in advance of the game.</li><li>■ Finally, it's time to livestream or video conference with your gamers! Reference our <a href="#">how-to livestream</a> resource for help getting started. Make sure that your fundraiser contains a donation link. If you use Facebook or Instagram Live to host your Bingo game, you can fundraise for the Jimmy Fund directly on your livestream.</li><li>■ Randomly generate Bingo letter-numbers on <a href="#">BingoMaker.com</a> and call them out on your livestream so your supporters can play! Instruct participants to comment “Bingo” when they win.</li></ul> |
| <b>Other Tips</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Play multiple rounds and offer prizes for the winners!</li><li>■ Not a Bingo fan? Host a trivia night or translate this event style to any online game of your choosing!</li></ul>  |
