

## **Official Rules**

Effective July 13, 2020, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will invite eligible participants of the 2020 Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk (the “Event”), via email, social media, and the Event website (<http://www.jimmyfundwalk.org>), to participate in the Summer Steps Challenge. Participants who complete the following between July 13, 2020 at 12:01AM ET and August 31, 2020 at 11:59PM ET (the “Entry Period”) will be eligible to receive the prize described below (“Contest #1”): (i) visit the URL reflected in the invitation to download the Charity Miles mobile application (the “App”), (ii) supply all requested information in a complete and accurate fashion, and (iii) log a total of seventy-five (75) miles through the App during the Entry Period. Furthermore, the five (5) participants to log the most activities through the App as of 11:59PM ET on October 3, 2020 (“Contest #2”) will be eligible to receive the corresponding prize described below. Miles and activities may be logged through walking, running, or biking.

The winners of Contest #1 will be determined on September 1, 2020 at 10:00AM ET. The winners of Contest #2 will be determined on October 5, 2020 at 10:00AM ET. The Senior Vice President for Philanthropy, or their designee, shall be responsible for determining the names of the potential winners of Contest #1 and Contest #2.

The potential winners will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached after ten (10) days from the first notification attempt, or if a participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a participant declines “winner” status, that participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI’s sole discretion. Prizes will be delivered via a traceable method.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Contest(s), a participant must, as of the date of entry: (i) be registered for the Event\* and (ii) be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia. Jimmy Fund Walk staff and participants who register for the Event as a volunteer are not eligible to win a prize.

**CONTEST #1:** participants who log a total of seventy-five (75) miles through the App as described above during the Entry Period will receive one (1) Jimmy Fund hat, while supplies last. This prize has a fair market value of twenty-five dollars (\$25) each.

**CONTEST #2:** the five (5) participants to log the most activities through the App as of 11:59PM ET on October 3, 2020 will receive a Jimmy Fund Swag Box. This prize has a fair market value of up to two hundred dollars (\$200) each.

Prizes are non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should a prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

Any valuation of the prizes stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winners are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winners may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person defined as a DFCI employee winning over \$100 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form W-2 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in the Contest(s) described above, participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest(s), and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the Contest(s), including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the Contest(s). DFCI is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The Contests are governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the Contest(s), each participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.

Dana-Farber Cancer Institute is the sponsor of the Contests. DFCI is located at 450 Brookline Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts 02215.

\*To register for the Event, an individual must complete the following: (i) visit the Event website (<http://www.jimmyfundwalk.org>), (ii) supply all requested information in a complete and accurate fashion, and (iii) commit to the minimum fundraising requirement. The minimum fundraising requirement (registration fee included) for participants ages thirteen (13) and older registered as a virtual walker is one hundred dollars (\$100); the minimum fundraising requirement (registration fee included) for youth participants ages twelve (12) and under as of Event day (October 4, 2020) registered as a virtual walker is twenty-five dollars (\$25).
