Pediatric Neuro-Oncologist & Assistant Professor, Harvard Medical School

Dr. Mimi's research focuses on identifying genomic and epigenomic drivers of tumor formation in pediatric brain tumors. She completed her initial medical training and Ph.D. in Melbourne, Australia, before completing further subspecialty training in pediatric neuro-oncology at Dana-Farber/Boston Children's Cancer and Blood Disorders Center.

He completed his residency in internal medicine and a fellowship in hematology and oncology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, where he also served as chief medical resident. He joined Dana-Farber in 1996 and is a member of the Breast Oncology Center in the Susan F. Smith Center for Women's Cancers. Dr. Bunnell was named Dana-Farber's Chief Medical Officer in 2012.
